

What is "My Open Library"/MOL?

- A Library which has staffed hours and unstaffed hours open every day from 8.00am to 10.00pm
- Members (aged 16 and over) can sign up for the service
- Technology controls alarms,CCTV, lighting, door access, windows, printing and pc reservations
- Self-service access to services
- Offaly Libraries operate MOL as an additional service available to library members





My Open Library was launched in Banagher on the 27th March 2015

Why is this such a popular service?

- Delivers the Library as a 'Third Place'
- Flexibility of hours that enable "access for all"
- Key civic space which facilitates community interaction and collaborative learning
- "Living room in the square"
- A welcome for all sections of the community
- Technology as an enabler and enhancer of quality of life services

Using the MOL Service

MOL is an additional service users must apply for via an application form. All applicants must take part in the MOL induction session




- Access with Library card and PIN
- Digital signage provides information on safety and security
- Self service technology
- Children under 16 (Parents/Guardian)
- Young people 16-18 (Written consent of parent or guardian)
- All members are required to carry their mobile phone

Offaly Experience - Usage

- Operating very successfully for over 6 years
- Increase of almost 85% opening hours in Banagher & Ferbane
- Increase of 50% opening hours in Tullamore Library
- Significant increase in usage
 - 4,162 users have signed up for My Open Library
 - Since Jan 2015 150,473 visits
- Successes led to a pivot of focus towards students and commuters





Ferbane Library: A MOL Success Story- Year 1

- The Ferbane MOL opened on 6th October 2018 and is a huge success
 - 27% increase in stock issues with 10,560 issues between October 2018-September 2019
 - 23% increase in library visits during staff times, as well as 5,448 MOL visits
 - Visitor numbers exceeded 10,000 over this period, averaging 27 visits per day
 - Associated positive outcomes demonstrate great community engagement with 37% increase in adult members and a 14% increase in children's membership
