



The National Oversight and Audit Commission publishes Public Spending Code Report 2022

NOAC publishes today the 9th Public Spending Code for the local government sector.

The Public Spending Code (PSC) was developed by the Department of Public Expenditure, National Development Plan Delivery and Reform and it applies to all public bodies in receipt of public funds.

The Code brings together, in one place, details of the obligations of those responsible for spending public money and aims to ensure that all Irish public bodies treat public funds with care and to ensure that the best possible value for money is obtained whenever public money is being spent or invested.

This is the 9th Pubic Spending Code published by NOAC which is a composite report for the Local Authority sector.

NOAC reviews the quality assurance reports received from each of the 31 local authorities for compliance with the PSC process, compiles the material and publishes the PSC on its website on an annual basis.
