



Review of Monitoring Reports on Regional and Economic Strategies by Regional Assemblies

The National Oversight and Audit Commission, with the assistance of the Office of the Planning Regulator, published today a report titled the Review of Monitoring Reports on Regional and Economic Strategies by Regional Assemblies.

The Chair of the National Oversight and Audit Commission (NOAC), Michael McCarthy, on behalf of the NOAC Board has today announced the publication of NOACs report, *Review of Monitoring Reports on Regional and Economic Strategies by Regional Assemblies*.

The Report undertakes a review of the two-year monitoring reports of the Regional Spatial and Economic Strategy (RSES) reports prepared by the three Regional Assemblies of Ireland.

This research, undertaken on behalf of NOAC by the Office of the Planning Regulator (OPR), sets out key findings and recommendations that should assist in supporting the monitoring and implementation of the RSES. These key findings were shared with the Minister of Housing, Local Government and Heritage, Darragh O'Brien, T.D.
